

# Master Gardener's Fall Gardening Classes

## Making a Hypertufa Container

LOCATION: Hamlin Park (S. Grove Street & Prospect Avenue, in pavilion near tennis courts) in East Aurora.

TIME: 10:00 AM – 11:30 AM

Hypertufas are rustic, light-weight containers that look like stone, similar to ones used in English Gardens. Master Gardener Lyn Chimera will be leading this make-and-take workshop.

**For the Hypertufa workshop, each person will need to bring:**

1. Rubber gloves – protects your hands. The heavy duty ones work best.
2. A face mask as the cement is caustic to breathe in while it is being mixed.
3. OLD clothes and shoes! The cement mixture can stain clothes and shoes so please dress accordingly.
4. One form or containers to use as a mold not larger than a dish pan. Some ideas are, dish pan, salad or mixing bowl, small storage container, plastic storage-type containers work well. You can also use plastic pots or containers from the dollar store. Anything where the sides are wider at the top than the bottom or at least straight. The inside of the

containers should be smooth as we will be building the Hypertufa on the INSIDE of the form.

5. Plastic bag that will fit as a liner for your forms. This is so the Hypertufa will slide out easily when completed.
6. A hand trowel for scooping out the mixture and smoothing the sides.


