<u>Cornell Cooperative Extension of</u> <u>Erie County 4-H Scholarship</u>

The purpose of the Erie County 4-H Scholarship is to recognize those 4-Hers that exhibit a high degree of leadership and community service due to their involvement in the Erie County 4-H program.

- Only complete applications will be considered.
- A complete application must include at least TWO letters of recommendation: 1 from a 4-H person of leadership and the other from whomever you choose (not a family member).
 - Letters may be turned in with the application or sent to the 4-H office separately. We recommend members collect the letters and tuning all materials in together to ensure the application is complete.

Scholarships awarded will be *at least* \$250 at the discretion of the scholarship selection committee.

Scholarship funds are based on the results of fundraising efforts made the previous year.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be currently enrolled in the Erie County 4-H program.
- Applicant must have been a member of the Erie County 4-H program for at least one year.
- Applicant must be a senior in High School or College Freshman
- Applicant must be enrolled or planning to attend an accredited university, college, technical school or certificate program.

Selection Process

- Applications are due in the 4-H office or postmarked by **April 17, 2023**
- Applications are reviewed by the scholarship selection committee.
- Applicants will be notified by **June 2**, **2023**
 - Scholarship check will be awarded upon receipt of proof of enrollment in the form of a tuition bill from the college, university, or program

Scholarship application and all required materials are to be postmarked no later than April 17, 2023
