There is an award application included with this introduction. The basic rules are listed below:

Deadline: Must be postmarked by May 15th, 2023

Format: Application must be submitted on the official application document (or copy thereof). The application must be typed, printed or neatly handwritten. The essay must be typed or printed. Any application that is illegible will be dismissed. Essay must include solutions for farming with NYS mandates regarding fossil fuels and environment. Applicants are encouraged to include input from interviews with farmers and

other agricultural industry representatives, as well as their own research.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Currently an Erie County resident, who is an active FFA/4-H member in good standing, **and/or** pursuing an agricultural course of study in grades 7 through 12. Applicant or family **does not** need to be a current Farm Bureau member.

Nomination: Applications may be completed by self- nominating students <u>or</u> by their current FFA advisor, 4-H Leader or Teacher.

<u>Award:</u> The awards will be presented at the Erie County Fair. The winners will be advised of the date, time, and location.
